










Morgan Fountain Artist Unknown End of Front Avenue




"Mickey Watcher"

Median at 11th Street & Broadway




Mural By Mike Howard 1000 Bay Avenue






"Memory Bomb"

Median between 11th & 12th Street




"Lenora Myers Sarling Fountain" Artist Unknown Intersection of Buena Vista & Wynnton Road










