


About the cover: "Dragonfly Banners" by Michael Vaughn Sims Broadway Parkade


Michael Vaughn Sims is a fine artist and theatrical designer currently active in Lowndes County, Alabama and Columbus, Georgia. He holds a BFA from Auburn University Department of Theatre and an MFA from Yale School of Drama. A professional theatrical designer since 1992, Sims began painting full-time in Alabama's Blackbelt in 2008. Sims created the "Dragonfly Banners" for Artbeat 2017 on Broadway in Columbus to coordinate with the new outdoor recreation initiative called the dragonfly trail. These are the first hanging banners in the Public Art Collection of Artbeat and Sims' first public art commission. Sims used his skills as a theatrical scene painter and designer to paint the banners. Sims finds inspiration in the study of art history, architecture and the natural world. Regarding his artistic aims Sims states, "I want my pictures to portray the kind of world in which I would like to live. I hope to shape the world around me through the images I produce."










